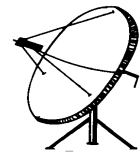

The Big Event of Amateur Radio! As we watch the biggest event for Amateur Radio of 2020 fade into the rearview mirror there is one last order of business. Each operator should complete the ARRL Field Day contest submission using their logs and bonus point information. Entry submissions must be completed by July 28, 2020. Most questions about your entry can be answered using the information from the ARRL Field Day website, <http://field-day.arrl.org/>. Entries are best accomplished with an online submission via the ARRL site as outlined in the following directions. Each operator is responsible for filing their own submission with the callsign used during Field Day activities. This should be the licensed operator's call. Do not use the TAARS call for your submission. Your entry will be combined with all entries associated with The Albemarle Amateur Radio Society for an aggregate score. Each submission will also receive an individual score.

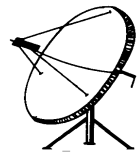
Operator/Station Photos and Narratives Operators are encouraged to provide a photo or two of their contest station. We also ask for a few words about your experience with the ARRL Field Day 2020. If you tried something new this year tell us about it! Share the good and the bad, the highs and the lows. This is how we get better at our hobby. If you found a new way to log, share it with the club. A new power source for your rig? Watch a nice sunset while making that west coast QSO? All information received will be added to a presentation for the club members. All members are highly encouraged to contribute anything of interest. We would like to hear from you! 4. Data required includes: (NOTE: An icon next to each entry item will display the applicable rule).

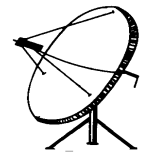
- a. Call Used. Your call sign used when operating your station.
- b. Location. For most of the club this is US Call Area 4, North Carolina or Virginia.
- c. Club or Group Name. Select “The Albemarle Amateur Radio Society” from the drop down.
- d. Number of Participants.
- e. Number of Transmitters. (on the air at one time).
- f. Entry Class. (Most operated a home station, either commercial or emergency power).
- g. Power Source.
- h. Power Multiplier.
- i. Select Bonus Points applicable to your entry.
- j. Band / Mode QSO Breakdown. Listing by CW, Digital or Phone and the transmit power setting.
- k. Attach the list of QSOs. Cabrillo file format is an option.
- l. Enter your name, email and call sign to digitally sign your entry and submit.

5. ARRL will provide an acknowledgement of your entry with scoring criteria. We suggest you save this to a pdf file. ARRL will also email the same information to your provided email address.

6. A list of entries received by ARRL can be found at: <http://field-day.arrl.org/fdentriescvcd.php>. Once the list is displayed make sure it is sorted by “Call Sign”. To find your callsign use the search mode in your web browser which is normally selected with the CTRL and F keys simultaneously. You can also search for all entries submitted for The Albemarle Amateur Radio Society.

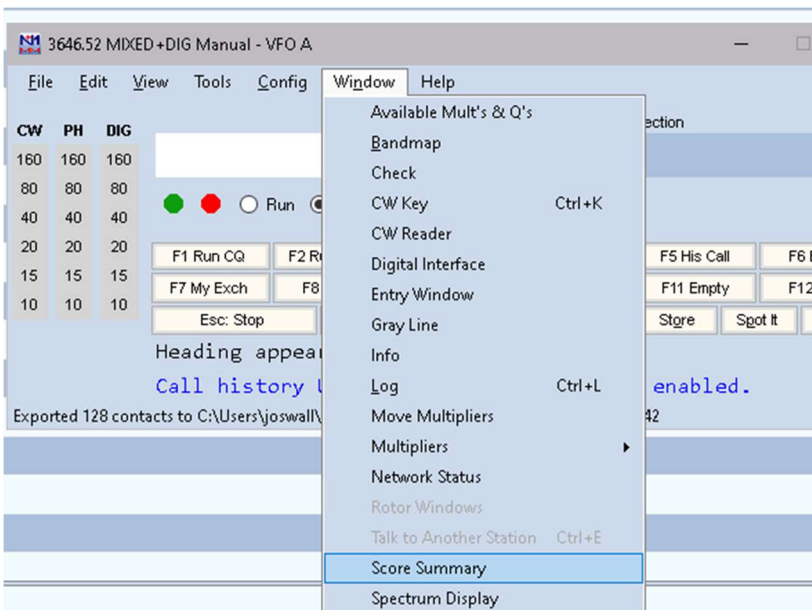
